

## 6 UCSB EAP- CALI Training & BARC Payments

Dear UCSB EAP Reciprocal Exchange Students,

This email contains information about your CALI Trainings (orientations), fee payments in BARC, the EAP Office holiday closure, and important reminders.

### Online CALI Training

Your online orientation is ready! You must complete the mandatory [online CALI Training](#) *before* you attend the in-person CALI Training on January 4. It covers many important topics and answers to frequently asked questions that will not be discussed at your in-person CALI Training.

### In-person CALI Training

Your mandatory in-person orientation starts at **9:30am Friday, January 4** at the Isla Vista (IV) Theater 2 on Embarcadero Del Norte and Trigo Roads (quadrant F8 on the [campus map](#)), followed by a walking tour and lunch, and will end by 1pm. Check-in will be open from 8:45-9:30am to pick up a free EAP t-shirt and other welcome information. Please eat breakfast before you come, and wear comfortable shoes.

### BARC Payments

All EAP Reciprocal Exchange students will need to pay fees through your UCSB [BARC account](#). You can log in with the same UCSBNetID and password that you use for GOLD. Check your BARC account often throughout your stay at UCSB as fees will be added periodically.

[Here are acceptable forms of payment](#) and information on extended [payment plans](#).

Fees charged to your BARC account may include:

- UC Student Health Insurance Plan (UC SHIP) Fee: \$1,120 per quarter (unless you have an approved UC SHIP waiver). **Winter UC SHIP must be paid by January 11\***.
- CALI training fee (orientation): \$50. This fee will be billed to your account a couple weeks after CALI training.
- College of Letters & Science Instructional Technology Fee: \$2.50 per unit fee is capped at 15 units per quarter (for a maximum of \$37.50 per quarter) is assessed only to courses in the College of Letters and Science. The fee will be billed to your BARC account in the fourth week of the quarter.
- Lab or equipment fees (if applicable)
- UCSB housing fees (if applicable)
- Student health fees (if you use the student health center)
- Late fees (if applicable)

These fees are also outlined in your [UCEAP Pre-arrival instructions](#).

\*You may receive statements from the UCSB Billing Office (BARC) stating that your BARC fees are due in December 2018. As an UCEAP student, you are automatically granted an extension to pay these bills, so you will not incur a late payment fee for your health insurance fee as long as you pay by **January 11, 2019**.

Although UCEAP students are granted an extension until January 11, you may be denied free access to the Recreation Center and/or a bus sticker (which allows you to ride the bus for free) until all fees are paid. It's recommended that you pay your BARC fees as soon as possible.

If you receive a “late registration fee” in your BARC account, please send an email to [RegRegistration@sa.ucsb.edu](mailto:RegRegistration@sa.ucsb.edu) to explain that you are a new UCEAP reciprocal exchange student, and request to have the fee reversed.

### **UCSB EAP Office Holiday Closure**

The UCSB EAP Office will be closed and I will not have access to email from **December 22, 2018 – January 2, 2019**. I will be reachable by phone and email on January 3 and 4, and I will be at your in-person CALI Training on the 4th (but the physical EAP Office will remain closed until Monday, January 7). **If you have any questions of concerns about your arrival please contact me before December 22!** If you have a health or safety related emergency while we are closed please contact the 24/7 UCEAP Emergency Line at +1 805-893-4762.

### **Waivers for UC SHIP**

If your current health insurance will cover you while you are studying at UCSB, then you may be eligible to waive out of UC SHIP. However, there is strict criteria that must be met. Please follow the [waiver instructions](#), and you can submit your waiver request online to UCSB Student Health until **December 15**. You may still submit a late waiver request between **December 16-25** but you will be charged a \$50 late fee in your BARC account.

### **EAP Buddy Family**

You will be placed in a small group with other exchange students and a UCSB student buddy who can answer any questions you may have about student life, introduce you to Santa Barbara and Isla Vista, and invite you to events so you can meet American students. Please complete and upload your TB and immunization information before arriving at UCSB. If needed, you can complete your immunizations here at UCSB after you arrive. Your winter registration will not be affected, but if you do not complete this requirement by **February 6** you will be blocked from registering in spring classes. ### **Class Registration Reminder**

Your registration Pass 3 will begin on Monday, December 17. You must be enrolled in at least 12 units for winter quarter.
