Courses are available in most academic disciplines. During the fall term only, qualified Biology majors have the opportunity to take upper-division marine science courses at the Bamfield Marine Sciences Centre (BMSC), a unique research and teaching facility on the west coast of Vancouver Island. Students take 4 courses per term, each worth 6 UC quarter units (24 units per term).
