Students then study at either Pontifical Catholic University of Chile (La Catolica) or University of Chile (La Chile) and take courses with host university and international students Students take a full-time course of study while abroad: 18 UC quarter units for the semester (4-5 courses) Spanish language study is available at the University of Chile, but not required during the semester. HOUSING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> During the ILP, housing is prearranged in a Chilean home in one of Santiago's most pleasant neighborhoods: Providencia, Nuñoa, or Las Condes. After the ILP, students can choose to make their own housing arrangements: staying with a Chilean host family, renting a room in a private household or pensión (boarding house), or sharing an apartment or house with other UC, international or Chilean students. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In both Santiago and Villarrica, students will live in homestays with locals. These homestays will be organized for you.
