Bordeaux Fall/Spring Language & Culture	
Intensive Language Program (ILP) French 10	French 26
Bordeaux L & C content courses	Upper-division course credit, counting at the very least as electives toward the major or minor.
Special Research Project	The required special project provides extensive, focused writing instruction and help. A French literary or cultural topic may provide you specific course credit toward the French major or minor. See the undergraduate advisor to petition for specific credit in French.
