Coursework	<p>30 UC quarter units; Ulpan & 4-5 classes/semester.</p> <p>Take classes with international students in English. All students take a pre-semester 4 week intensive Hebrew language class "Ulpan". During the term, take 1 Hebrew or Arabic language class, and 3-4 courses from a wide range of humanities and social science subjects, or select a specialized track. Strong subjects include: Anthropology, Archaeology, Arabic, Art, Dance, Middle East Studies, Geography, Hebrew, History, Intl Relations, Music, Politics, Religious Studies, Sociology, and more. Internships and independent study are possible.</p> <p>**Fall students will need to arrange for early exams if they wish to return to UCSB for winter quarter.</p>	<p>9 UC quarter units; 2 classes.</p> <p>Take classes with local and international students in English. Choose from a list of courses focused on contemporary Israeli issues in the following subjects: Anthropology, History, International Studies, Middle East Studies, Religious Studies, and Urban Studies. Most classes include field trips. Letter grades only.</p>	<p>31.5 UC quarter units; 9-unit internship & 3-6 classes.</p> <p>Take classes with local and international students in English. The first nine weeks consist of a full-time, guaranteed internship and internship course in the field of Business, Science, Pre-Med, or Engineering, at a company or research lab. After the internship ends, take 3-6 courses in: Sciences & Engineering** (biotech/food, chemical, civil, mechanical), intro Computer language, beginning Hebrew, humanities subjects on Israeli topics, and Math.</p> <p>**Engineering classes are open to all majors, but not recommended for UCSB Engineering major requirements.</p>
Housing & Location	Students are required to live in secure on-campus dorms or apartments. Dorms are double rooms, 10 rooms to a hall and kitchen. Apartments are shared with 5-6 people in single or double rooms. All have shared bathrooms. HU is located on the eastern perimeter of Jerusalem, perched atop Mount Scopus.	Students are required to live in secure on-campus apartments in single rooms. HU is located on the eastern perimeter of Jerusalem, perched atop Mount Scopus.	Students are required to live in secure on-campus apartments with 3-5 people with single rooms and shared bathrooms and kitchen. The campus, located on Mount Carmel, is nearly as large as a small city, with stunning views of Haifa Bay.
