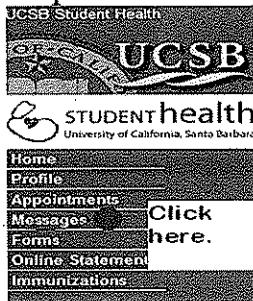


How to complete your EAP Health Clearance, Online through Student Health

1. Log on to <http://studenthealth.sa.ucsb.edu/>
2. Click on The Gateway to secure login.



3. Enter your UCSB NET ID and Password.
4. Once logged in click on **Messages** on the left hand side of the panel.



5. Then click on New Message link.



6. Then select EAP Medical Health Clearance and click continue. You are now ready to complete the form.

All students must have a health clearance in order to participate in EAP. The electronic Confidential Health History Form you are now filling out will be used in the EAP health clearance process. You **MUST** print a copy of this completed form and take it abroad with you. This form provides vital medical information in the event that you require emergency treatment.

In addition you must be able to pick up your Health Clearance Form at Student Health in person. No forms will be mailed.

A \$40 fee will be charged to your BARC account for use of this electronic service.
