Scholarship Application Tips

Steps for submitting a strong application:

Step 1:

Attend a Scholarship Workshop and research your options.

Step 2:

Brainstorm essay ideas and write a first draft.

Step 3:

Submit the first draft of your essay to eapscholarships@eap.ucsb.edu for the UCSB EAP office to review. Submit additional drafts, if desired.

Step 4:

Determine if you will need official transcripts and/or letters of recommendation. Get these documents in order ASAP and before the scholarship application deadline.

Step 5:

Submit all of your scholarship application materials by the deadline.
