<b>COURSEWORK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimum of four courses per semester; 24 UC quarter units</li> <li>• Courses in English in a large variety of subject areas with host country students: African diaspora studies, gender studies, political science, chemistry, literature, art, history, religious studies, sociology, Caribbean Studies, business management, international economics and tropical and marine sciences!</li> <li>• Field courses and lab work or an independent research project or internship available for academic credit</li> <li>• To request an internship, students must contact the campus study abroad advisor or UCEAP Program Specialist and provide an area of interest. Students also need to provide a resume, statement of purpose, and a letter of recommendation prior to departure.</li> </ul>
