COURSEWORK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students are enrolled in the Intensive Language Program (ILP) for the first month of the program (3-6 units). Students enroll in a Portuguese language class, along with 3-4 other courses in a variety of disciplines each semester, for a minimum of 18 UC quarter units. Courses in English are available but are more limited than regular university offerings. Attend classes with international and/or host country students. Participate in local community service and obtain internships for academic credit (Portuguese may be required). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students take an online language placement exam prior to arrival and are placed in an introductory Portuguese language course. Students enroll in one seminar course and one language course to meet the program requirement of 9 UC quarter units. Cultural activities are included in the curriculum. Internships and independent research opportunities for academic credit are not available for this program. Attend classes with international students.
HOUSING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prearranged homestay required the first month during ILP. After the ILP, students may find their own housing or remain in the homestay.
