

PROGRAM	Pontifical Catholic University of Rio de Janeiro (PUC-Rio)	Brazilian Seminars
ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS	 Level: Soph, Jr, Sr, Grad (by departure) Language: To take courses in Portuguese, 3 quarters of Portuguese <u>OR</u> 6 quarters (2 years) of Spanish is required (SPAN 6 or 16A). No language requirements to take courses in English. GPA <u>AND</u> Language GPA: 2.85 at time of application and maintained through last term prior to departure. (No language GPA requirement for English track) 	 Level: Soph, Jr, Sr (by departure) Language: None GPA: 2.85 cumulative at time of application and maintained through departure
WHEN	Fall: early August to late DecemberSpring: early March to mid-July	Summer: early July to early August

COURSEWORK	 Students enroll in a Portuguese language class, along with 4 other courses in a variety of disciplines each semester, for a minimum of 18 UC quarter units. Courses in English are available but are more limited than regular university offerings. View offerings here. Participate in local community service and obtain internships for academic credit (Portuguese may be required). Internships must be arranged by PUC-Rio for legal reasons, and students can not find opportunities on their own. 	 All students take an online language placement exam prior to arrival and are placed in an an introductory Portuguese language course. Students enroll in one seminar course and one language course to meet the program requirement of 9 UC quarter units. Cultural activities are included in the curriculum. Internships and independent research opportunities for academic credit are not available for this program.
HOUSING	 Prearranged homestay required during the first month. After the first month, students may find their own housing or remain in the homestay. 	Students live in a prearranged homestay in a Brazilian household located in one of the safest neighborhoods in the zona sul (southern zone) of Rio de Janeiro.
