The campus is about a 30-minute bus ride from downtown Vancouver.

COURSEWORK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Courses are available in the Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Education, Schulich School of Music, Faculty of Religious Studies, Faculty of Science, and Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences. • French language study is optional. • Students take a minimum of 4 courses per term, each worth 6 UC quarter units (minimum 24 units per term). 	Courses are available in most academic disciplines. During the fall term only, qualified Biology majors have the opportunity to take upper-division marine science courses at the Bamfield Marine Sciences Centre (BMSC), a unique research and teaching facility on the west coast of Vancouver Island. Students take 4 courses per term, each worth 6 UC quarter units (minimum 24 units per term).
