COURSEWORK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students then take a full-time course of study: 18 UC quarter units for the semester (4-5 courses) Both programs offer regular university courses in virtually all disciplines, predominantly taught in Spanish. PUC-Chile excels in the fields of education and psychology. It also has a strong program in the arts, and offers courses in law and literature taught in English. PUC-Chile also has course restrictions in health sciences, music and architecture. Univ. of Chile offers courses in business and economics taught in English. Independent study and internship opportunities are available for academic credit! Internship commitment is typically 8-12 hours per week. 	
HOUSING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will make their own housing arrangements: staying with a Chilean host family, renting a room in a private household or pensión (boarding house), or sharing an apartment or house with other UC, international or Chilean students. You will receive guidance from the Chile Study Center and have access to a list of homestay options.
