**Peking University (PKU/Beida)** The first national university in modern Chinese history and one of China's most prestigious universities, PKU is located in the Haidian District in the western suburb of Beijing and is near the Yuanmingyuan Garden and the Summer Palace.

**Tsinghua University** Established on the former imperial gardens of the Qing Dynasty in northwestern Beijing in 1911, Tsinghua University is a comprehensive university widely recognized for excellence in teaching and research. It is consistently ranked among the top institutions in international rankings, with particular strengths in the fields of science, engineering, management, and the humanities. The Tsinghua campus is famous for its beautiful gardens, shady trees, and diverse architecture.
