COURSEWORK	<p>You will take 22.5-27 UC quarter units, 5-6 classes per semester with US and international students. All courses are taught in English.</p> <p>At least three courses must be taken at the CIEE Study Center with other US students. You will also have the option of taking courses for international students at Charles University or at the Film and Television School of the Academy of the Performing Arts (FAMU), or pursuing an internship for credit.</p>	<p>One internship course for a total of 9 UC quarter units. Internship course can be taken for a letter grade or P/NP.</p> <p>You'll complete a full-time internship (minimum of 240 hours, around 25-30 hours per week) along with a hybrid workplace seminar course. During the academic seminar you will analyze and evaluate the workplace culture and the daily working environment you experience.</p>

Czech student Resident Assistants live separately. • Double room in an apartment arranged by CIEE with American students and one Czech "flat buddy". Apartments are shared with other students. <p>All apartments are 20-45 minutes by public transportation from Anglo-American University and the CEA Prague Center. The commute to your internship location will vary.</p>
