	The AUC is an English-speaking university and UCEAP students will be fully integrated into the campus and classroom, having access to courses across the 39 undergraduate subjects ranging from arts and humanities to science and engineering. 95% of students are Egyptian with students from around the world representing in the other 5%. Classes are small, from 20-30 students, making it easy to form relationships with fellow students and faculty. Some strengths include Communication, Egyptology, Environmental Studies, Gende Studies, History, Journalism, Marketing, Media Studies, Middle East Studies, and Political Science. 3000 and 4000 level courses are upper division. Modern Standard Arabic and Egyptian Colloquial Arabic courses are optional and are offered at every level from elementary to high advanced.	
	Informal internships, community service, and volunteering are possible. Research for academic credit may be possible with advanced planning, please contact the UCSB EAP Advisor.	
Housing, Location & Activities	The new, secure, garden-like campus is set in a residential neighborhood of New Cairo. Students are required to live on campus in single or double rooms, complete with linens, AC, gym access, and a diverse array of food options. This lively campus invites students to join student organizations and sports teams to meet local Egyptian students as well as students from around the world. Model Arab League and Model UN are popular. A range of wellness, counselling, medical clinic, career services, and other support services are available. The international office oraganizes free and affordable activities, excursions, and trips.	
	Ramadan takes place in spring 2026, and Egyptians know how to celebrate! AUC's schedule shifts to support fasting students, and food options continue to be available to non-fasting students. Nightly breaking of the fast is joyous on-campus and out in the community, and all students are welcome to participate. Ramadan at AUC has become a destination in and of itself.
