



<u>Coursework</u>	During the first four weeks of instruction, students enroll in four courses with an Indian perspective of the following:

	2) Growth, Development & Sustainability
	3) Gender, Culture & Society
	4) Technology, Innovation & The Future of Work
	During the final two weeks, students participate in <u>fieldwork</u> for academic credit, volunteering with community development initiatives and exploring a topic of their choice.
