Students with Korean citizenship must apply for this program as a Korean citizen, even if they have dual nationality with another country.</li> <li>• Male students who have Korean citizenship either by birth or blood may be subject to military service if they are 18-36 years old and have not satisfied their Korean military service requirement.</li> </ul>

Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2.00 cumulative GPA at the time of application and maintained through departure</li> <li>• Soph, Jr, Sr, or Grad</li> </ul>
Coursework	<p>Students enroll in 2-3 courses taught in English in humanities, social sciences, management and economics, East Asian Studies, and Korean Studies.</p> <p>A limited number of competitive research and business <a href="#">internships</a> available. Most corporate internship providers require intermediate Korean language ability. If you participate in an internship, you may only enroll in one additional course.</p> <p>Korean language study available from beginning to advanced levels.</p> <p>Browse courses <a href="#">here</a>.</p>

**Korea University** is a private university on par with the US ivy leagues The campus is spacious, green, hilly and just 25 minutes from the heart of Seoul by subway.

**Seoul National University** (SNU, called Sha) is Korea's #1 public university located in the southern part of Seoul. The campus is hilly and large, comprising about 1,000 acres beneath the Gwanak mountains. The campus has an impressive Museum of Art and one of the nation's most prestigious libraries.

**Yonsei University** is a private research university set on the former site of a royal palace. It is among the three most prestigious schools in South Korea. Yonsei University is located right in front of Shinchon, a lively college neighborhood full of restaurants and exciting nightlife.
