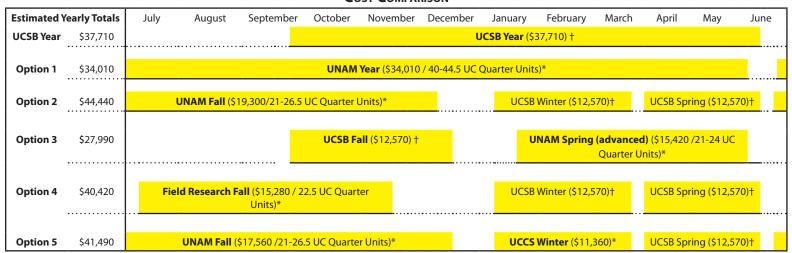

COURSEWORK	 ILP (Intensive Language Program): Two courses, 8.5 UC quarter units Fall: Min. 4 courses and 18 UC quarter units Spring: Min. 4 courses and 21 UC quarter units The Spring (Advanced) option does not include an Intensive Language Program (ILP). Students participating in this option must be mature and have strong Spanish skills to prepare themselves for courses at UNAM. Internships available for Art, Community Services, Education, Government and Public Relations fields Research opportunities available Attend classes with local students 	Fall: Four courses; 22.5 UC quarter units Hands-on experience and training in research with a Mexican professor/mentor at one of EAP's sites in Yucatán, Oaxaca, Chiapas, Queretaro or Mexico City (final site choice depends on the research topic) Intensive Language Program (ILP) for the first month in Mexico City Students attend classes with UC students in Mexico City during first half of the program, and conduct independent reseach for the second half of the program	Mexico City ILP (Intensive Language Program): Two courses, 3-8.5 UC quarter units Mexico City UNAM: Students enroll in courses at UNAM and begin an online leadership course in the late summer and fall; 3-4 courses + leadership course for total of 18 UC quarter units Sacramento: Students assume internship placement and coursework at UC Sacramento Center (UCCS); 2 courses for total of 14 UC quarter units Units: Total with ILP, UNAM courses and UCCS: minimum 35 quarter units Students attend classes with UC students and host country students.
