Housing	Prearranged homestays in both locations. Housing is NOT provided during the break between Buenos Aires and Santiago. Students must manage their luggage during this time. No storage is provided.	Students will live in shared apartments. Housing is prearranged by the ACCENT staff in each location. Housing is provided during the break between locations. Travel to Turkey is a prearranged group flight. Travel between locations in Italy are arranged by each student on their own.	Housing is prearranged for you by the ACCENT staff in each location. In London, live in shared apartments in a double room with other UC students. In Paris, live in a single studio in a residence hall. All housing is within 30 min of the study center by public transportation.
