Take regular university courses taught in English with Dutch, UC, and other international students. Host universities offer an interactive education system that focuses on teamwork and group projects.

Description	Small liberal arts and sciences honors college (~600 students). Classes are small and taught w/ Problem-Based-Learning methodology, similar to graduate seminars at UC. Maastricht is in the south of the Netherlands, close to the borders of Belgium and Germany.	Small liberal arts and sciences honors college (~700 students). Classes are small and similar to graduate seminars. Active participation is encouraged and expected. UCU has a residential, close-knit feel. The city of Utrecht is located 30 minutes away from Amsterdam by train.	Large university (~30,000 students). Lecture-style courses and small tutorials in a variety of disciplines. The largest and one of the oldest universities in the Netherlands. Utrecht has the largest student community in the Netherlands and is considered a top academic destination in Europe.

Program	Psychology & Neuroscience, Maastricht University	Biological and Life Sciences, Maastricht University	Maastricht Summer
Description	Intended for psychology majors. Courses focus on the latest topics in psychology like Motivation and Emotion, Forensic Psychology, Cognitive Enhancement, and Hormones, the Brain and Behavior. Take courses through Maastricht's Center for European Studies (CES). Courses selected from a set list of options. Some courses include field trips. • Fall semester: four courses, 24 units total • Spring quarter: two courses + Independent Study Project, 14.5 units total	Intended for students studying biology, and life sciences. Courses explore genetics, clinical nutrition, molecular biology, etc. Take courses through Maastricht's Center for European Studies (CES). Courses selected from a set list of options. Some courses include field trips. • Fall semester: four courses, 24 units total	Courses with a European perspective taught in English in a variety of subjects of humanities and social sciences. Students take two courses and earn a total of 10 UC quarter units. This is a 6 week program.
