<b>Description</b>	Small liberal arts and sciences honors college (~600 students). Classes are small and taught w/ Problem-Based-Learning methodology, similar to graduate seminars at UC. Maastricht is in the south of the Netherlands, close to the borders of Belgium and Germany.	Small liberal arts and sciences honors college (~700 students). Classes are small and similar to graduate seminars. Active participation is encouraged and expected. UCU has a residential, close-knit feel. The city of Utrecht is located 30 minutes away from Amsterdam by train.	Large university (~30,000 students). Lecture-style courses and small tutorials in a variety of disciplines. The largest and one of the oldest universities in the Netherlands. Utrecht has the largest student community in the Netherlands and is considered a top academic destination in Europe.

This program is intended for Economics majors and is a great match for students who want to focus on business and economics in their study abroad program.</p> <p>The Problem-Based Learning (PBL) method, unique to Maastricht, takes a scholarly approach to addressing practical issues. It emphasizes group work and critical thinking.</p> <p>Take 4 courses (24 units).</p>	<p>Wageningen University's agricultural and food science programs rank among the best in the world.</p> <p>Many courses in are offered in English, and the program takes advantage of unique academic offerings in food technology and consumer science.</p> <p>Wageningen is a historic town situated on the Rhine river in the central Netherlands, about an hour from Amsterdam by train.</p> <p>Take 4 courses (20 units).</p>
