

Description	Small liberal arts and sciences honors college (~600 students). Classes are small and taught w/ Problem-Based-Learning methodology, similar to graduate seminars at UC. Maastricht is in the south of the Netherlands, close to the borders of Belgium and Germany.	Small liberal arts and sciences honors college (~700 students). Classes are small and similar to graduate seminars. Active participation is encouraged and expected. UCU has a residential, close-knit feel. The city of Utrecht is located 30 minutes away from Amsterdam by train.


