Beginning and intermediate Norwegian language is also offered. Field trips and social activities are included.	24 UC quarter units; 3 classes per semester. Take classes with local students in a range of subjects. Strengths include: Biosciences, Chemistry, Communication, Computer Science, Economics, Geosciences, History, Media Studies, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Scandinavian Studies, and more. Masters classes can be taken for UD undergrad credit.	24 UC quarter units; 3-4 classes per semester. Take classes with local students.
