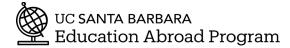

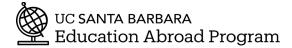

COST COMPARISON



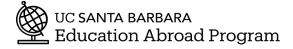

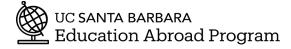

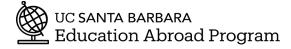
