Thammasat University is one of the top universities in Southeast Asia and is known for its student activism and interest in Thai politics. The university's international programs taught in English are based on the main campus of Tha Prachan in the Chao Phraya riverfront area of central Bangkok. Within easy walking distance are some of Thailand's most sacred temples, the Grand Palace (the Emerald Buddha Temple), the National Theater, the National Museum, and many government ministries.
