Study: Earn 21-24 UC quarter units (2-6 classes) per semester. Fully immerse yourself in British culture by attending a host university in England. You will take your classes and live alongside local UK and international students.

Research and independent study are possible. Year-long students may independently pursue an internship, however it is uncommon for college students to intern in the UK.

Course availability varies by university. Refer to the Academic Offerings Guide at the end of this packet to determine which universities offer certain subjects and any restrictions.

When: (varies by university): Fall semester: mid Sept. to mid Dec. Spring semester: Jan. to late May or late June Year: mid Sept. to late May or late June

Application Notes: Rank at least 2 university preferences. Submit the UCEAP English Universities application online before 11:59pm on the deadline; submit the Statement of Purpose and Academic Planning Form only for your first choice university. You will receive instructions to submit a host university application online a couple months after the UCEAP application deadline. If you are not accepted to your first choice university, you will be notified to submit the host university application for your second choice, etc. Final placement is determined by the host university.

Acceptance to King's College London and University College London are competitive; be sure to research and rank alternatives.

How to Choose a University

- What classes do you need/want to take while you are abroad? Does the university offer classes in that subject during the term you're going?

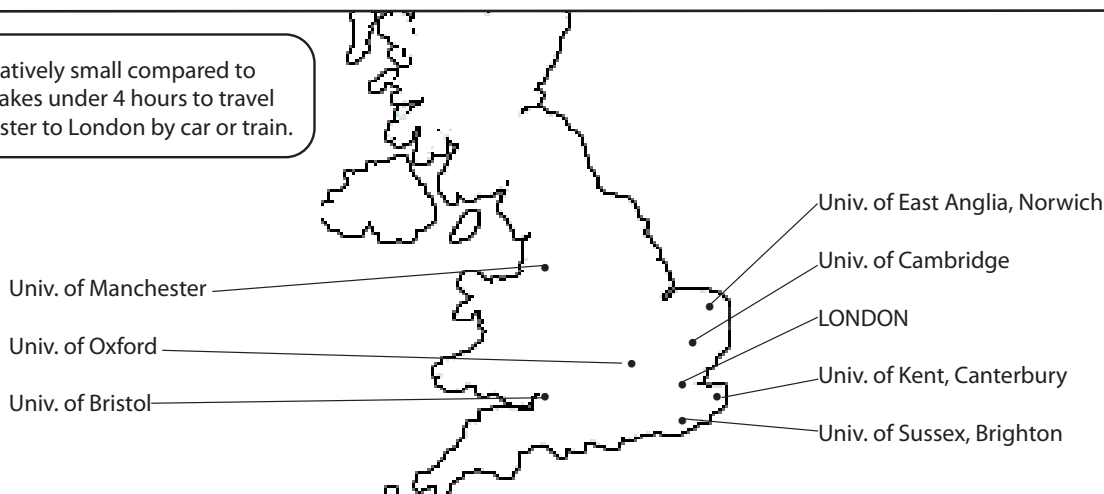
First check the Academic Offerings guide located on the [English Universities website](#) by selecting any university, then Academics, then scroll down to Catalogs and Resources to see Academic Offerings. Then, you may also use the historical [Gaucho Credit Abroad database](#) to see what classes past UCSB students took abroad and what degree requirements they counted toward, or the historical [UCEAP Course Catalog](#) to see where past UC students have taken classes in your subject (offers a keyword search), but **the best place to find the full, most current course list is the host university's course catalog**, which can be found on the [UCEAP English Universities](#) website by selecting a university and then "Academics".

- Do you want to study in a small or large university? Are you interested in a small or large city?

Students applying to London universities should be independent and prepared to navigate a fast-paced major city. Housing may be far from classes via public transportation. Living costs will be higher than other cities in England. Imperial College, King's College, and University College London do not have centralized campuses. Placement at King's and UCL is competitive. If you still want a big city experience, consider Manchester or Bristol.

England is relatively small compared to California. It takes under 4 hours to travel from Manchester to London by car or train.

ENGLISH UNIVERSITIES ACADEMIC OFFERINGS (updated July 2021)

This is an overview of subject areas available at each host institution. This is not an exhaustive list.

The list is subject to additional restrictions found in the full version of this guide online.

We also recommend you check each host university's Study Abroad/Visiting Student module catalog to see what classes are currently available to you as it changes year to year.

These can both be found at uceap.universityofcalifornia.edu/programs/english-universities, select a university, then select Academics.

- There will be some courses in your subject that will be based in a different department (e.g. women's studies classes in sociology).
- UK second-year courses are usually considered "equivalent" to the junior year. Many first-year classes are still upper-division.
- If you are considering University College London it is essential that you research class restrictions as there are a number of them.
- General subject area restrictions across all host institutions:
 - Courses in **science**, **math**, and **engineering** may be limited for Fall-only options. Please check with the individual university if alternative assessment is available.
 - Most **law** courses at U.K. host universities are for law majors only, and most are year-long courses. If you are a law major semester student and you want to take law courses, you can do so at the University of Manchester, the University of London, Royal Holloway, the University of Sussex, and on a case-by-case basis at the University of Kent.
 - There are no courses in **medicine** open to UCEAP students in England.
