How UCEAP Works

COURSE CREDIT

All courses taken through UCEAP are UC units and will automatically be posted to students' UCSB transcripts after returning from abroad. Courses can then be petitioned to fulfill major, minor, or GE requirements.

With proper planning even double majors can study abroad and graduate on time.

ELIGIBILITY

All majors in good academic standing can study abroad. Minimum eligibility requirements vary by program, such as class standing (Sophomore-Grad Student), GPA (2.0-3.5), and language level (0-2+yrs), and are stated on each program's webpage.

Most applicants who meet the minimum requirements and turn in a well-written statement and complete application are admitted. However, some programs are competitive due to limited space.

COST

Participants continue to pay UC tuition fees, which are paid to UCEAP and not the host institution. Additional UCEAP fees and cost of living vary by program. Total cost estimates are available on each program's webpage.

Longer programs in affordable countries are the best deal. Many year-long programs cost less than staying at UCSB and are listed later in this booklet.

FINANCIAL AID

UCSB financial aid, including grants, scholarships, and loans will be repackaged based on the cost of the program and follow you abroad.

Year Programs That Cost Less Than Staying at UCSB

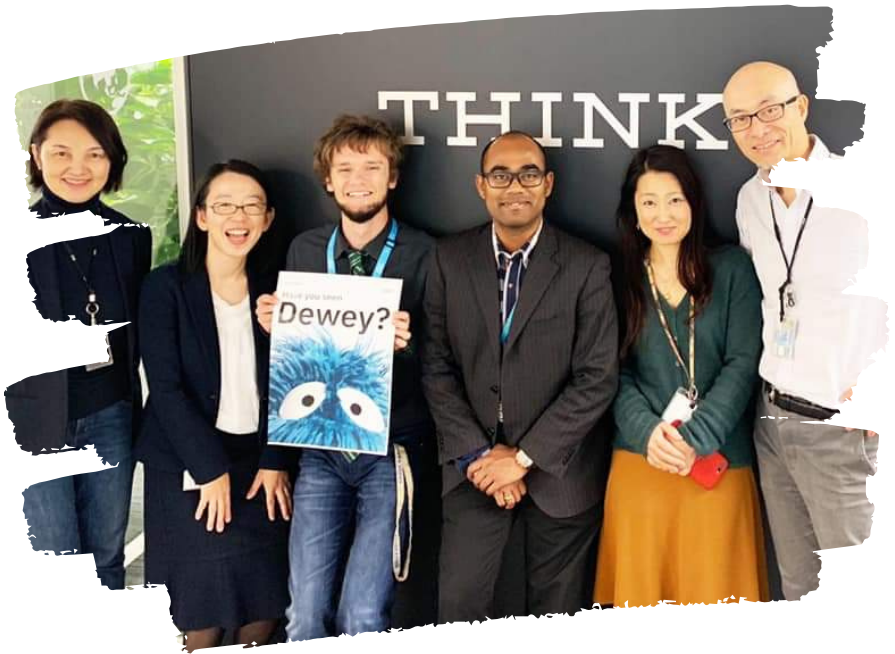
