General Summary of Duties and Responsibilities

The Video Peer Advisor will provide assistance to the UCSB Education Abroad Program (EAP) and Capital Internship Program (CIP) Staff in the following areas:

- Developing and implementing innovative video strategies and content for EAP/CIP with the goal of increasing the number and diversity of participants
- Creating online video materials and ensuring consistent messaging
- Assist in maintaining the YouTube Channels for EAP/CIP

Duties include:

- Creating videos from start to finish including videotaping and editing
- Organizing video collection via spreadsheets
- Communicating with staff regarding video needs
- Communicating with students to set-up times to record
- Updating videos on the website/Youtube channel/Instagram/TikTok
- Providing ideas to the staff about effective videos that could be created
- If requested, oversee a small group of video interns who will assist with video projects
- Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications

Please note that participation in a UCEAP/CIP program is **NOT** a requirement for this position.

- Experience with video editing software, preferably Premiere Pro
- Experience with creating videos
- Ability to work independently AND be able to take direction / constructive feedback from the staff
- Ability to be flexible AND responsive to email communication and requests

Must have an interest in promoting the EAP/CIP and be willing to learn as much as possible about both programs. Creativity, reliability, attention to detail, and ability to take initiative are highly desirable. Must be willing to use Gmail, Google Calendars, Google Spreadsheets, Box, and Zoom for work purposes. Must represent EAP/CIP in a professional manner, including a mature and courteous attitude and a strict regard for student confidentiality. When needed, also work with the reciprocal exchange students and should be culturally sensitive.

To be eligible for the position, you must be a full-time student registered for at least 12 units for the Fall 2025, Winter 2026 and Spring 2026 quarters. Your graduation date must be Spring 2026 or later. You will not be eligible for the position if you intend to graduate at the end of fall or winter quarter.
